Aughton – Christ Church MIs. The newer church in Aughton, consecrated 1877. Copied inscriptions from the original ODFHS paper version, includes list of names and maps of the graveyard. Inscriptions encompass 1880-1997. Last updated 1997. CD 15.6MB. Price £6.00	
Aughton – St. Michael MIs. The older church in Aughton, even mentioned in the Domesday Book. Copied inscriptions from the original ODFHS paper version, includes list of names and maps of the graveyard. Inscriptions encompass 1655-1997. Last updated 1997. CD 5.53MB. Price £7.00	
Beaconsall Old Church MIs. This old Church is down a lane and next to the River Douglas (formerly River Asland). This disc includes photographs (JPEG) of the graves, inscriptions encompass 1762-2011. DVD 844MB. Price £10.00	
Bickerstaffe Holy Trinity MIs. Built 1843. Copied inscriptions from the original ODFHS paper version, includes list of names and maps of the graveyard. Inscriptions encompass 1843-1997. CD 2.77MB. Price £7.00	
Burscough St. John, Roman Catholic MIs. Actually on the border of Burscough and Lathom, founded 1793. Copied inscriptions from the original ODFHS paper version, includes list of names and maps of the graveyard. Inscriptions encompass 1812-1997. CD 4,700 KB. NOTE Burscough's C of E church is also called St. John. Price £4.50	
Burscough St. John, Church of England MIs. Memorial Inscriptions only. A "Waterloo" design church, opposite Burscough Bridge railway station, consecrated 1832. Inscriptions encompass 1832-2008, with additions revealed to 2012, over 4,000 grave spaces, but not all have inscriptions, also memorials within the church. NOTE Burscough's RC church is also called St. John. CD 11.00 MB. Price £12.00	
Burscough St. John, Church of England. Photographs of gravestones and church interior. This DVD contains photographs (JPEG) to accompany the MIs CD and shows all graves visible in 2008/2012. 2 GB. It is sold separately but is available at a better price combined with the MIs CD. Price £10.00	
Burscough St. John, Church of England. Set of two discs, containing MIs and photographs. Price £15.00	
Lydiate St. Thomas, Church of England MIs (and some Catholic Graves). This church was built about 1841, and has a larger graveyard than Our Lady's RC, Lydiate. When Our Lady's graveyard became full, some Catholic interments occurred in St. Thomas's. Copied inscriptions from the original ODFHS paper version, includes list of names and maps of the graveyard. Inscriptions encompass 1822-1997. CD 900 KB. Price £7.00	
Lydiate Our Lady's, Catholic Church MIs. Built 1886; when the graveyard became full, some interments occurred in Lydiate St. Thomas, C. of E. This DVD was produced in 2016. It consists of photographs of the graves, maps and interior; graveyard and interior of the church as well as the Memorial Inscriptions found; cross -referenced, searchable. Inscriptions encompass 1856 to 2014. JPEG photographs of the graves. DVD 1.5 GB. Price £10.00	
Maghull St. Andrew's Church of England NEW Graveyard MIs. The new church was consecrated in 1880. Early burials were in the Old Chapel graveyard (see Maghull Old Chapel MIs on DVD). These Memorial Inscriptions encompass 1904 to 2010, and include photographs (JPEGs) of the graves and graveyard. DVD 2.4 MB. Price £10.00	
Maghull St. Andrew's OLD Chapel Graveyard MIs. The small Chapel remaining on the site is still consecrated and services are occasionally held. Some parts of the building are Norman and photographs of the interior are included. Some of the graves are worn and illegible but the grave of Frank Hornby (inventor of Meccano) is one in good condition. Inscriptions encompass 1740-1986. JPEG photographs of the graves. DVD 1.14 MB. Price £10.00	
Ormskirk St. Peter and St. Paul Church of England MIs. This is the Parish Church of Ormskirk and is the only church known to have a Tower and a Steeple at the same end. The Tower and its bells were brought from Burscough Priory at the Dissolution of the Monasteries in the time of Henry VIII. (Many graves; inscriptions amount to 132,892 words including the paths [see other CD], the notes and inscriptions within the church). There is a MASTERSEARCH file to assist in searching. CD 31 MB. Ormskirk Graveyard, St. Peter and St. Paul Church of England MIs. In the later-1900s the Parish Church of Ormskirk began a "modernisation". The gravestones around the church were lifted and laid as paths (some being laid face-down). No proper records were kept of the work. The ODFHS found various records, and work over a two-year period resulted in identifying most of the spaces from where stones had been removed. A grave-digger's notebook furnished details of most grave owners, their occupations and many interments (c.1844 -1909). JPEG photographs of the notebooks and maps. CD 350 MB. Price £10.00	
Ormskirk St. Anne's Roman Catholic Church MIs. Opened in 1850. This CD contains pages copied (with permission) from a survey led by the Catholic Family History Society, and completed in 1983. Includes some inscriptions for Polish WWII deaths. Interments 1852-1983. CD copies of printed pages in JPEG format. CD 30 MB. Price £5.00	
Rufford St. Mary's Church of England MIs. Opened in 1869, formerly a chapel of Croston Parish, this CD holds 212 pages copied in 1995 from microfiche. Memorials of the Hesketh family are noted. Inscriptions encompass c.1693-1995. JPEG photographs of the pages. CD 23 MB. Price £10.00	
Scarisbrick St. Mark's Church of England MIs. Built about 1851; previously worshippers attended Ormskirk Parish Church. Inscriptions encompass 1858-2014. JPEG photographs of the church. CD 5.9 MB. Price £6.00

Scarisbrick St. Elizabeth's Roman Catholic Church MIs. First Catholic services took place at Scarisbrick Hall (see CD of BMD records), before St. Mary's Church was built on Hall Lane. St. Elizabeth's replaced St. Mary's in 1888, designed by Pugin (who was also involved with the Houses of Parliament). Inscriptions encompass 1848-2004. JPEG photographs of the church and individual graves. CD 355 MB. Price £10.00	
Westhead St. James' Church of England MIs. St. James is above the village of Westhead, but also includes Lathom (Although Lathom Park Chapel is ancient, it has only a few graves. Ormskirk was used before St. James was built). Consecrated 1851, inscriptions encompass 1855-2004. Includes JPEGs of the church plans. CD 28 MB. Price £7.00	
Bickerstaffe Quakers. In the 17th century, the Bickerstaffe area was strongly Quaker. This CD includes extracts from various books and records of Births, Marriages and Deaths (BMDs) from c.1650-1800, including burials in the Quaker Graveyard on Graveyard Lane. CD 255 KB. Price £7.00	
Burscough Beef Awards. Charitable people paid for beef to be distributed to housekeepers in Burscough. 7 lists of names covering 1800-1817 and 7 lists covering 1819-1825 (both donors and recipients, 3,600 words). JPEG photographs of the pages. (This data is included on the Burscough Township Books DVD.) CD 80 MB. Price £5.00	
Burscough Township Books (including Burscough Beef Awards). Burscough Township Books record names and duties of Officials from 1770 to 1850. As well as 9 duties such as Churchwardens and Assessors of Window Tax, there is also a list of Paupers. JPEG photographs of the 262 pages. This DVD includes the Burscough Beef Awards described above. DVD 2.0 GB. Price £10.00	
Burscough and District Boatmen and their Families. This CD was produced in 2007 as a supplement to our www.boatfamilies.website . It comprises extracts from local censuses, churches, newspapers and some commentary. JPEG photographs of people and places. CD 75 MB. Price £10.00	
Burscough St. John C of E Grave Owners and Burial Records. The CD comprises photographs of the burial books, covering the period 1832-1960; with searchable transcriptions and grave plans. 352 pages (in JPEG format). CD 171 MB. Price £5.00	
Halsall St. Cuthbert Burial Books 1950 to 2019 etc. The Church have allowed us to photograph pages of various books and transcribe them. Burial books from 1950-2019 (most entries include the address) plus extras e.g. Damaged book of Names for various sections, Re-written list of details made in 1988. There is a MASTERSEARCH list (in Excel format). A DVD of the relevant graves is planned after COVID-19. Price £6.00	
Maghull Overseers Accounts. The accounts books, covering the period 1827-1828, were saved from a waste skip. They were very difficult to read so this CD only contains an Excel spreadsheet of the data. Includes many names of poor residents of Maghull, expenses (e.g. for a hearse) and the names of vestry Officers. CD 212 KB. Price £4.00	
Maghull St. Andrew's C of E Church Records. Photographs of all the books appertaining to the NEW graveyard and Cremations, with transcriptions. Photographs and transcriptions of the Interior. Many sections, covering the period from c.1894-2010. There is a MASTERSEARCH file to assist in searching. JPEG photographs of the pages. CD 467 MB. Price £6.00	
Ormskirk Advertiser Newspaper Extracts. CD of extracts, transcribed by a Member (searchable). Very varied contents e.g. Local churchwardens appointed in 1872; Birth Notices 1865-84; Homes for sale in Ormskirk, 1871-74. CD 6 MB. Price £7.00	
Ormskirk Dissenting Meeting Baptisms (also called Fogg's Chapel). The Chapel stood on land off Aughton Street. Founded 1784, to replace the Chapel on Chapel Lane (founded 1696). Baptisms from 1743-1837. Includes photos of Henry Fogg's grave stone, now in a footpath. 19 searchable pages 3 JPEG photos of the grave. CD 6.9 MB. Price £5.00	
Ormskirk Land Tax Records #1 1781-1790. The first of 3 CDs (each can be purchased separately). Includes a list of Workmen who rebuilt the Town Hall in 1799-80 and supplied items (e.g. Richd Taylor for Dantzig Balks {timber}). 212 JPEG photographs of the pages, transcriptions as PDFs and an index of names. CD 522 MB. Price £5.00	
Ormskirk Land Tax Records #2 1799-1805. This CD has more names than #1. 188 JPEG photographs of the pages, transcriptions as PDFs and an index of names. CD 372 MB. Price £5.00	
Ormskirk Land Tax Records #3 1827-1831. This CD has more names than #1 and #2. 225 JPEG photographs of the pages, transcriptions as PDFs and an index of names. also extracts from Baines' Directory for Ormskirk in 1825. CD 450 MB. Price £5.00	
Ormskirk Land Tax Records ALL THREE CDs together. This pack of three CDs allows purchasers to possibly follow ancestors' families through a period from 1799 to 1831. Also to assess the changes and growth of Ormskirk during that time. CD details as above. Price £10.00	
Scarisbrick St. Elizabeth's R.C. Interior and Mass Cards. Includes MIs in the interior and photographs (including the windows). Mass Cards from c.1915-2003. 19 searchable pages. JPEG photos. CD 150 MB. Price £5.00	
Scarisbrick St. Elizabeth's and St. Mary's BMDs. Early Catholic records in Scarisbrick begin in the Hall itself. St. Mary's RC Chapel was built in 1812, and replaced by St. Elizabeth's Church in 1889. Baptisms (1773-1824), Marriages (1773-1856), Deaths (1826-1856). CD 378 KB. Price £7.00

Tarleton Manor Court Records. Various records covering 1696-1802 e.g. Court Barons (split into 11 searchable sections). The area is low lying and prone to flooding; this data shows many individuals being fined for failing to clear watercourses. Includes a dictionary of specialist terms. CD 896 KB. Price £7.00	
Carrington Papers. The Carrington Family held land in Ormskirk which was compulsory purchased to build the Liverpool-Preston railway line. We have been allowed to photograph all the documents (including maps) and develop abstracts. They start with a Title held by Thomas Scarisbrick 31/05/1751 and end at 31/01/1977. There are also some similar documents for Southport Road (north of the Parish Church) about 1824 to 1986. Word 97 format, which can also be used on more modern computers. 322 photos in JPEG format. Worrall's Directory 1872. A Member has copied his directory. 302 pages, covering a very large area, starting in Wigan but extending to many parishes around Ormskirk. Includes names and occupations (e.g. butchers, coopers, drapers). JPEG photos. CD 145 MB. Price £3.00	
1851 Census Indexes plus Strays and Surnames, and War Memorials. This CD began as a simple list of names to be found across our district. It has been expanded by the addition of lists of Surnames, all matched to the appropriate page in the 1851 censuses. Also included is a list of War Memorials in our district and the names on each (in PDF format). CD 19 MB. Price £5.00	
Our First 14 Magazines (1991-1997). This compilation includes many interesting snippets, (e.g. Inhabitants of Ormskirk in 1366) and copies of two early ODFHS newsletters (1984 and 1988). PDF of the pages. CD 314 MB. Price £3.00	
Burscough Tithe Maps ~1840. There are photographs of the entire maps and close-ups of sections. This CD has three sets, as new versions were produced when the railways through Burscough were proposed. Also a schedule (including names of landowners and occupants of land). NOTE - some present-day parts of Burscough were part of Lathom in 1841, so are not shown here. JPEG photographs. CD 77.5 MB. Price £10.00	
Rufford Tithe Map ~1839. There are photographs of the entire map and close-ups of the sections. An Excel transcription of the Schedule (including names of landowners and occupants of land). JPEG photographs. CD 11.0 MB. Price £5.00	
Scarisbrick Tithe Map ~1839. This CD was produced by a member who hand-copied the map, transferred it to computer format and identified the areas. Includes a history and explanations as well as the Schedule (e.g. names and land). The disc contains the map in various formats - Word and Excel 97, PDF, TurboCad. CD 116 MB. Price £10.00	
Tarleton Tithe Map ~1840. There are photographs of the entire map and close-ups of the sections. Includes an Excel transcription of the Schedule (e.g. names and land). JPEG photographs. CD 11.0 MB. Price £5.00	
BOOK The Derby Chapel in Ormskirk Parish Church. Lathom was the original seat of the Earls of Derby, who used Burscough Priory as their church. At the dissolution of the Monasteries, the Derbys started a chapel within the church with effigies. Written by ODFHS member J. Gidman, this small booklet describes the chapel, with excellent colour photographs. Price £4.00	
BOOK Sir William Stanley of Holt. Also by J. Gidman, this is the story of "A Yorkist Martyr", brother of the first Earl of Derby. Sir William held office in Cheshire, and was very involved in the Battle of Bosworth (where Richard III was killed). It is reported that he offered the Crown of England to Henry Tudor. Price £5.95
